2007 REVIEW

BACK-TO-BACK WINNING SEASONS

Washington State posted a 28-26 record in 2007 marking the first time the Cougars have had a winning record in consecutive seasons since 1993-94. WSU was 36-23 under Donnie Marbut in 2006. Marbut has won 85 games, the most by a Cougar head coach in his first three seasons on the Palouse.

COUGARS FINISH STRONG IN CONFERENCE

After losing nine of the first 10 Pacific-10 Conference games, the Cougars roared down the stretch to post series wins against No. 12 Arizona, Stanford, No. 15 Oregon State and UCLA and finish 10-14 in conference games, placing in a tie for sixth with Oregon State. The four series victories are the most in conference play since the Pacific-10 reunified in 1999. The Wildcats, Beavers and Bruins all advanced to NCAA postseason play with Oregon State capturing the national title.

EIGHT COUGARS GRAB ALL-PAC-10 HONORS

Sophomore second baseman Travis Coulter, senior pitcher Wayne Daman, Jr., junior infielder Paul Gran, sophomore pitcher Ross Humes, sophomore catcher Greg Lagreid, junior pitcher Jayson Miller, senior infielder Jeff Miller and junior outfielder Simi Reynolds were named 2007 All-Pacific-10 Conference honorable mention. Coulter started 41 games, batted .310, and collected a team-leading 16 doubles. Daman, Jr. made 14 starts, posted a team-best 3.28 earned run average and tied for the team lead in wins with five. Gran started 51 games, batted .314, led the team with 64 hits, and was tops among regulars with a .495 slugging percentage. Humes made 25 appearances out of the bullpen and established a single-season Cougar record with 12 saves. Lagreid started 45 games, hit six home runs and drove in 25 runs. Jayson Miller was 5-2 in 18 appearances, nine starts, and struck out 6.35 batters per nine innings. Jeff Miller made 53 starts, batted .295, and led WSU with eight home runs and 36 RBI. Reynolds led the Cougars with a .347 batting average while making 26 starts in his 42 appearances.

COUGARS IN THE CLASSROOM

Washington State had six student-athletes earn 2007 All-Pacific-10 academic honors. Pitchers Steve Kost (3.62 grade point average, in accounting) and Jayson Miller (3.68, accounting) gained first team accolades. Catcher Greg Lagreid (3.34, business) and outfielder Scott Suttmeier (3.30, finance) were selected to the second team. Pitcher Jeremy Johnson (3.17, undeclared) and outfielder Jared Prince (3.06, social sciences) were named honorable mention.

MURPHY'S DEFENSE

Junior first baseman Jim Murphy posted a .996 fielding percentage committing just two errors in 468 chances. The mark is fifth-best on Washington State's single-season list.

SAVES RECORDS

Led by sophomore Ross Humes's single-season school record 12 saves, the Cougars established a team-record 18 saves. It was the second straight season WSU broke the school record for saves after 17 in 2006 bested the 1971 mark of 16.

PAC-10 PITCHER OF THE WEEK TIMES THREE

Washington State freshman Connor Lambert, sophomore Ross Humes and junior Jayson Miller all earned a Pacific-10 Conference Pitcher of the Week honor in 2007. Lambert earned the award March 6 after blanking Air Force on two hits and striking out 10 in a 3-0 victory over the Falcons March 2. It was the first collegiate start for Lambert. Humes received the accolade April 24 after posting a win and two saves in three appearances. He notched a save in a 7-4 win at Gonzaga April 17 with two and a one-third innings of scoreless relief. In a 4-3 win at No. 12 Arizona April 21, he struck out three and earned a save in one and one-third innings. He retired all four batters he faced, including a pair of strikeouts, to pick up a win against Arizona April 22. Miller's honor came May 15 following a May 13 outing against 2007 national champion Oregon State in which he limited the Beavers to one run on four hits while striking out five in eight innings of work. The victory gave WSU a series win over Oregon State.

COULTER NAMED PAC-10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sophomore Travis Coulter was named Pacific-10 Conference Player of the Week, April 24 after batting .545 during a three-game stretch. In a series-clinching 5-3 victory over No. 12 Arizona April 22, Coulter tied the WSU school record with three doubles and drove in a run. He was 2-for-5 in a 7-4 win at Gonzaga April 17 and 1-for-3 with a triple during a 3-1 loss to Arizona April 20.

DAMAN, JR. SIGNS FREE AGENT CONTRACT

Pitcher Wayne Daman, Jr. signed a free agent contract with the St. Louis Cardinals following a four-year career with the Cougars. The right-hander made 67 appearances for Washington State, including 45 starts, and won 21 games for the Crimson and Gray. He finished his career with 197 strikeouts, ninth on the Cougar career list. As a senior, he posted a 5-4 record with a team-leading 3.28 earned run average. His professional career began in Batavia, N.Y., the Cardinals' short-season A affiliate in the New York-Penn League.

HALL OF FAME INDUCTION

Former Washington State University Head Coach Charles "Bobo" Brayton and pitcher/first baseman John Olerud were two of 15 college baseball greats among the College Baseball Hall of Fame 2007 induction class. When he retired from WSU in 1994 after 33 years leading the Cougars, Brayton ranked as the fourth winningest baseball coach in NCAA Division I history with 1,161 wins. A member of the WSU Athletic Hall of Fame, Brayton, who led the Cougars to 21 conference titles in 33 years, was named Pacific-10 Conference Northern Division Coach of the Year five times and West Coast NCAA Regional Coach of the Year once. Olerud spent three years in a Cougar uniform, hitting .434 for his career (160-for-369) with 37 doubles, 33 home runs 131 RBI and a .824 slugging percentage. On the mound he posted a 26-4 record with a 3.17 ERA and 169 strikeouts in 39 appearances. Inducted into the WSU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001, Olerud left Pullman as the school's career leader in batting average and slugging percentage and ranked in the top five in home runs and pitching wins. In 1988 he was named *Baseball America's* NCAA Player of the Year after hitting .464 with 21 doubles, 23 home runs, 81 RBI and 83 runs scored. That same season he was 15-0 on the mound with a 2.49 ERA.
