WASHINGTON STATE (11-16, 4-14 Pac-10)

COUGARS AND DUCKS AT PAC-10 TOURNAMENT: The Washington State men's basketball team is the No. 10 seed at the Pacific Life Pac-10 Tournament...Cougars play No. 7 seed Oregon, Wednesday, March 8...game is scheduled for 8:42 p.m. (time approximate following Arizona State/Oregon State game...FOX Sports Net will televise the game.

THE HEAD COACHES: Dick Bennett is 36-48 at Washington State and in his third season on the Palouse...owns a 490-307 career record (.615) in 27 collegiate seasons...guided Wisconsin to 2000 Final Four...Oregon's Ernie Kent is 162-111 with the Ducks and in his ninth season in Eugene...career record is 262-191 in 15 collegiate seasons...Bennett is 0-6 against Kent...Bennett is 1-7 against Oregon, including 0-6 at WSU.

COUGARS AT THE PAC-10 TOURNAMENT: Washington State is 2-6 all-time in Pac-10 Tournament games...lost to Arizona State in 1987...defeated UCLA and lost to Oregon State in 1988...beat Oregon and lost to Arizona in 1989...lost to USC in 1990...suffered defeats to Stanford in 2004 and 2005...Cougars did not qualify for tournament in 2002 or 2003...all 10 teams made the tournament 1987-90 and in 2006.

SERIES WITH THE DUCKS: Oregon leads 151-116...Ducks have won 10 straight in the series and 18 of the last 19...only Cougar victory in last nine seasons was 63-62 in Pullman, Feb. 15, 2001...Oregon has won eight of 12 meetings on a neutral floor, including an 8-2 record at the Far West Classic in Portland, Ore...WSU has won the two previous meetings in conference tournament play, both played in California...Cougars defeated Ducks 50-37 in Pacific Coast Conference Tournament, Dec. 28, 1948...game played in San Francisco...WSU knocked off Oregon 78-56, March 9, 1989 in first round of Pac-10 Tournament played in Inglewood, Calif.

HAIRSTON BUZZER BEATS DOWNS COUGARS: Oregon's Malik Hairston nailed a 3-pointer from the left corner with four tenths of a second remaining in the game to give the Ducks a 52-50 win over the Cougars, Jan. 19 in Pullman...Jordan Kent had 13 points and 12 rebounds for Oregon...Washington State's Josh Akognon led all scorers with 18 points.

DUCKS ROUT COUGARS: Oregon led 30-10 at halftime and rolled to a 67-37 win over Washington State in Eugene, Feb. 18...Chamberlain Oguchi tallied a game-high 18 points for the Ducks...Robbie Cowgill led the Cougars with 11 points...Oregon held a 45-28 advantage on the boards.

ABOUT OREGON: The Ducks are 13-17 overall, 7-11 in the Pac-10...finished outright seventh to earn No. 7 seed in Pac-10 Tournament...Malik Hairston ranks 10th in the Pac-10 with 14.4 points per game...Ducks are averaging 68.6 points on offense and give up 64.6 points on defense.

THIS DATE IN COUGAR HISTORY (March 8): Washington State solidified its first postseason bid in nine seasons with an 82-68 win over No. 8 USC in Pullman, March 8, 1992...win was the 20th of the season for the Cougars who eventually advanced to the second round of the National Invitational Tournament before losing to New Mexico 79-71.

COUGARS CONTINUE TO BREAK STREAKS: Washington State has accomplished several firsts and has broken many losing streaks under the tutelage of Dick Bennett...here is a look at Cougar highlights over the past three seasons.

- Won 57-51 at Alaska Fairbanks, Nov. 22, 2003 to break 27-game road losing streak.
- Won 55-50 at California, Jan. 4, 2004 to break 31-game losing streak in California, 22-game Pac-10 road losing streak, six-game skid to Golden Bears and eight-game slide at California.
- Won 76-61 over USC in Spokane, Jan. 10, 2004 to halt nine-game losing streak to USC.
- Won 55-48 at UCLA, Feb. 5, 2004 for first win at UCLA in 47 games, including 39 at Pauley Pavilion...broke 22-game losing streak to UCLA.
- Won 60-51 at USC, Feb. 7, 2004 to snap seven-game losing streak at USC...first season sweep of USC since 1985-86...completed first road sweep of Los Angeles schools in WSU history.
- Won 60-51 vs. Stanford in Spokane, Dec. 31, 2004 to break 17-game losing streak against Cardinal.
- Won 70-63 at No. 11 Arizona, Jan. 29, 2005 to break 38-game losing streak against Arizona...stopped 20-game losing streak at Arizona...first win in 35 tries against a ranked Arizona team...halted a 26-game road losing streak against ranked opponents and a 48-game skid overall against top 25 teams.
- Won 59-48 at Stanford, March 3, 2005 to break eight-game losing streak at Stanford...first home-and-home sweep of Stanford since 1992-93.
- Won 78-71 at No. 10 Washington, Jan. 7, 2006...first win at Washington since 1994...first win in 57 games against a top 10 team on the road...broke 34-game losing streak to top 10 teams.
- Defeated No. 16 Washington, Feb. 4, 2006...first home-and-home sweep of the Huskies since 1994...first ranked opponent defeated at Friel Court since No. 25 California (89-87), Feb. 22, 1997 (23-game losing streak).

RETURN TO SENDER: Washington State has 125 blocked shots this season, including 86 in Pacific-10 games...fifth time in school history Cougars have eclipsed the century mark in rejections during a season...only 1986 (130) team ranks ahead of this year's squad...the 86 blocks in conference play broke the school record set in 1986 (72).

COUGARS TAKE CARE OF THE BALL: In the Cougars 71-62 loss at Oregon State, Feb. 16, Washington State committed four turnovers...dating back to 1977 (school game records are incomplete prior), the four turnovers ties the school record for fewest in a game...WSU turned the ball over four times in an 82-79 win over Oregon Jan. 19, 1991.

WASHINGTON STATE DEFENSE: The Cougars lead the Pac-10 in scoring defense (57.4 points per game), field goal percentage defense (39.0) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.5).

COUGARS ARE SLOW STARTERS: Washington State has led just once at halftime in its last 13 games, 11 of which have resulted in losses...Cougar victories came at home against Washington (trailed 35-30) and USC (tied 20-20).

WHO IS STARTING?: Washington State has used 22 different starting line-ups in its 27 games this season...sophomore Derrick Low started the first 11 games before breaking his right foot in practice, Jan. 4...Low missed eight games, came off the bench against UCLA, Feb. 9 and returned to the starting lineup against USC, Feb. 11...Robbie Cowgill has started all 24 games in which he has played after missing the first three due to a fractured right clavicle...Kyle Weaver game against Stanford, Feb. 25 due to a sprained left ankle.

- Appeared in all 27 games, including 13 starts.
- Made first career start against UC Riverside, Nov. 19...recorded 22 points, and career-high eight rebounds against the Highlanders.
- Scored 13 points at No. 9 Gonzaga, Dec. 8.
- Tallied 10 points in 13 minutes off the bench in 61-46 win over Portland, Dec. 17.
- Posted career-high 27 points, including 17 in the second half, off the bench in 78-71 win at No. 10 Washington, Jan. 7...named U.S. Bank Pacific-10 Player of the Week after Washington game.
- Was 6-for-8 from 3-point range and went 5-for-5 at the line to tally a game-high 25 points (all in second half) at No. 11 UCLA, Jan. 12...notched 19 points, three boards, and two steals at USC, Jan. 14.
- Led scorers with 18 points vs. Oregon, Jan. 19...tied career-high eight boards vs. Oregon State, Jan. 21.

- Recorded 12 points and added 10 boards at California, Jan. 28...first career double-double.
- Scored 13 points and grabbed season/career-high 13 rebounds against No. 16 Washington, Feb. 4...first played to record back-to-back double-doubles since J Locklier in 2001-02 season.
- Grabbed 10 boards and added seven points against Stanford, Feb. 25.
