2005-06 SEASON REVIEW

The 2005-06 Washington State men's basketball season was filled with milestones, heartbreak losses and ultimately the retirement of head coach Dick Bennett and the hiring of his son Tony as his successor.

The Cougars roared to a 7-2 nonconference record including a thrilling 58-57 win over Kansas State in Pullman, a 60-49 victory at eventual Mountain West champion San Diego State, and a 69-42 route of Utah at KeyArena in Seattle.

WSU improved to 9-3, 2-1 in the Pac-10 when it defeated No. 10 Washington 78-71 on the road, Jan. 7. The victory marked the first in school history on the road for the Cougars over a top 10 team. Unfortunately, the next three games all resulted in close losses and WSU's season unrayeled.

At UCLA, Kyle Weaver missed a layup at the buzzer and the Cougars lost 63-61. Two nights later, Josh Akognon had the ball stolen in the waning seconds with WSU down a bucket at USC and the Trojans posted a 71-66 victory. When the Cougars returned home the following week, Oregon broke their hearts when Malik Hariston nailed a 3-pointer with 0.4 seconds left to give the Ducks a 52-50 victory.

Despite the eventual 11-17 record, including a 4-14 mark in the Pacific-10, Washington State had several accomplishments during the 2005-06 campaign.

- Won 78-71 at No. 10 Washington, Jan. 7, 2006...first win at Washington since 1994...first win in 57 games against a top 10 team on the road...broke 34-game losing streak to top 10 teams.
- Defeated No. 16 Washington, Feb. 4, 2006...first homeand-home sweep of the Huskies since 1994...first ranked opponent defeated at Friel Court since No. 25 California (89-87), Feb. 22, 1997 (23-game losing streak).
- Washington State tied the school record for blocked shots in a season with 130 (set in 1985-86)...Cougars rejected 86 opponent attempts in conference play to eclipse the previous school record of 72 set during 1985-86 campaign...Robbie Cowgill led the team with 33 blocked shots for an average of 1.32 per game.
- At Oregon State, Feb. 16, Washington State committed four turnovers...dating back to 1977 (school game records are incomplete prior), the four turnovers tied the school record for fewest in a game...WSU turned the ball over four times in an 82-79 win over Oregon Jan. 19, 1991.
- The Cougars led the Pac-10 in scoring defense (57.7 points per game), field goal percentage defense (38.9) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.9)...
 Cougars also led in field goal percentage defense (40.6) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (31.0) during Pacific-10 play.
- Sophomore Robbie Cowgill was named to the 2006 Pacific-10 Men's Basketball All-Academic First Team...Cowgill carries a 3.38 grade point average and is a management options major...ninth WSU men's basketball student-athlete and first since J Locklier in 2002 to be named to the first team...became the second underclassmen at WSU to garner the honor (sophomore Carlos Daniel, 1996)...sophomore Chris Henry was
