Oregon State (17-13, 7-11) vs. Washington State (15-15, 7-11)

March 7, 2012 • Noon • Staples Center • Los Angeles, Calif.

THE GAME: Oregon State takes a two-game winning streak to Los Angeles where it will face Washington State in the opening game of the Pac-12 Tournament at noon on Wednesday at the Staples Center.

QUICKLY: Oregon State has clinched a winning season for just the second time since 1990 ... Craig Robinson (60) has more wins in his fourth season than Hall of Famers Ralph Miller (58) and Slaty Gill (57) had in their first four years at Oregon State ... The Beavers lead the Pac-12 in scoring (79.6), steals (9.3, fifth in the nation) and blocked shots (4.6) ... Jared Cunningham has scored in double figures in 22 consecutive games and continues to lead the Pac-12 in scoring (18.2) and steals (2.6) ... Ahmad Starks has made 10-of-16 three-pointers in the last three games and is third on Oregon State's single-season three-pointers made (67) and attempted (185) lists... Devon Collier leads the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (.605) and is fifth in blocked shots (1.33) ... Angus Brandt is seventh in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (.550) and leads the Beavers in three-point field goal percentage (.480) ... Eric Moreland tied Oregon State's single-season record with 37 blocked shots in conference games (tied with Nick DeWitz and Scott Haskin who did it twice).

vs. WASHINGTON STATE: Oregon State lost both games to Washington State this season as the Cougars won 81-76 on Dec. 31 in Spokane, Wash., and 83-73 on Feb. 9 at Gill Coliseum. The Beavers hold a 163-121 advantage in the series and a 4-3 edge in neutral site games, but Washington State has won the last four meetings between the two teams.

Oregon State and Washington State have played one time previously in the Pac-12 Tournament with the Beavers winning 74-68 in double-overtime in the semifinals on March 12, 1988. Oregon State was the No. 2 seed and the Cougars were the No. 6 seed that year.

The winner of this year's first round game will play the No. 1 seed Washington Huskies on Thursday at noon on FSN.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT NOTES:

- Oregon State is the No. 9 seed and Washington State is the No. 8 seed in this year's opening round matchup.
- The Beavers are 6-12 in conference tournament games and Washington State is 5-12.
- Oregon State defeated Stanford, 69-67, in the opening round of the Pac-10 Tournament last season as the No. 9 seed when the Cardinal was the No. 8 seed.
- The Beavers' last win in the tournament before last season was a 71-68 victory over Arizona State on March 8, 2006.
- The No. 9 seed is 5-5 vs. the No. 8 seed all-time in conference tournament games.
- The No. 9 seed is 5-10 all-time in conference tournament games.
- Jared Cunningham was named to the All-Tournament Team last season and joined Gary Payton (1988 and 1989) as the only Beavers to make the team.
- The Pac-12 Tournament was played from 1987 to 1990 and returned in 2002 after an 11-year absence.
- Oregon State great A.C. Green will be inducted into the Pac-12 Hall of Honor during the tournament.

OFFENSIVELY: Oregon State is first in the Pac-12 and ninth in the nation in scoring at 79.6 points per game. The Beavers have never led the conference in scoring (team statistics began in 1959-60). Oregon State's highest scoring average in a full season was 78.4 points per game in 1989-90.

MORE OFFENSIVE RANKINGS: Oregon State is second in the Pac-12 in assists (15.9) and field goal percentage (.471) and fourth in scoring margin (+6.8). The 15.9 assists per game are tied for 16th in the nation and the Beavers' best average since 1991-92 (17.7). Oregon State leads the conference in free throws made (539, 20th in the nation) and free throws attempted (788, seventh in the nation).

DEFENSIVELY: Oregon State leads the Pac-12 and is fifth in the nation in steals at 9.30 per game. The Beavers led the conference in steals last season (9.5, fifth in the nation) and in 2009-10 (8.2). Individually, an Oregon State player led the conference in steals the past two seasons with Jared Cunningham (2.8) in 2010-11 and Seth Tarver (2.2) in 2009-10.

DEFENSIVELY II: Oregon State has forced a Pac-12 best 516 turnovers (17.2 per game) this season, including 20 or more turnovers in nine games. The Beavers have fewer turnovers than their opponent in 22 of their 30 games this season and are second in the Pac-12 with a +3.2 turnover margin.

DEFENSIVELY III: Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in blocked shots at 4.6 per game after getting 10 against Colorado and a single-game team record 11 against Stanford in the quadruple-overtime game. The last time the Beavers led the conference in blocked shots was 2005-06 when they finished with 4.7 per game.

MISCELLANEOUS STATISTICS: Oregon State is outscoring their opponents in several specialty statistics, including points off turnovers (613-433), second chance points (401-380), points in the paint (1,076-888) and fast break points (292-166).

STARTING FIVE: Oregon State has used five different starting lineups this season after Angus Brandt gave his starting spot to Kevin McShane on Senior Day against Colorado. The Beavers had started Jared Cunningham, Ahmad Starks, Eric Moreland, Devon Collier and Brandt for four straight games before the regular season finale against the Buffaloes.

LOOKING TO JOIN AN ELITE LIST: Jared Cunningham leads the Pac-12 in scoring (18.2) and steals (2.57) and could become just the sixth player to lead the conference in both categories since they started keeping steals statistics in 1978.

CUNNINGHAM SCORING WATCH: Jared Cunningham moved into 21st on Oregon State's career scoring list with 1,173 points after passing Marcel Jones with 15 points against Colorado, and into the top-five on the Beavers' junior scoring list. He has scored in double figures in 22 consecutive games, by far the longest streak of his career (previous high was nine games last season).

JARED MOVING UP THE LIST: Jared Cunningham is seventh in the nation at 2.57 steals per game. He has 205 in his career and is tied with Ray Blume for second on Oregon State's career steals list. He has 77 this season and moved into the top-five on the Beavers' single-season steals list and holds down two of the five spots after coming away with 85 swipes last season.

JARED FROM THE STRIPE: Jared Cunningham is tied for eighth in the nation in free throws made (179) and fifth in free throws attempted (237) to lead the Pac-12 in both categories by a wide margin. The 179 free throws are second on Oregon State's single-season list, trailing only Mel Counts who made 237 in 1963-64. Cunningham has already moved into the top-five on the school's career lists in makes and attempts.

STARKS STEALING: Ahmad Starks has 51 steals this season, after coming away with 18 all of last season, and is seventh in the Pac-12 at 1.70 per game. The 51 steals is the fourth most by a sophomore in Oregon State history, trailing only Ray Blume (63), Gary Payton (72) and Jared Cunningham (85).

STARKS FROM DEEP: Ahmad Starks leads the team in three-pointers made (67) and attempted (185) after doing the same last season as a freshman (42-for-130). He has knocked down a triple in 26 of the 30 games, including two or more in 20 games, and is third on both Oregon State's single-season three-pointers made and attempted lists.

COLLIER SHOOTING: Devon Collier leads the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at 60.5 percent (141-of-233) and has made 50 percent of his shots or better in 25 of the 30 games. The last Oregon State player to lead the conference in field goal percentage was Scott Haskin in 1991-92 (.612).

COLLIER SCORING: Devon Collier is 16th in the Pac-12 in scoring at 12.8 points per game and has scored in double figures in 23 games this season, the second-most on the team, including a streak of 12 consecutive games. He led the Beavers in scoring in consecutive games against Vanderbilt and Towson and scored 20-plus points in back-to-back games against Arizona State and UCLA, accomplishing both for the first time in his career.

FRESHMAN IMPACT: Eric Moreland is making an impact during his redshirt freshman campaign as he leads the team in rebounding (6.4) and blocked shots (1.8) to rank seventh and second, respectively, in the Pac-12. He is second on Oregon State's freshman rebounding list and moved into third on the Beavers' single-season blocked shots list after shattering the school's freshman record with 55 swats.

DOING EVERYTHING ON THE COURT: The versatile Joe Burton is 11th in the Pac-12 in rebounding (5.9), 16th in assists (2.8) and 11th in steals (1.2) -- and is the only player in the conference in the top-16 in all three categories. He's also ninth in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at 54.6 percent (100-of-183). He has led the Beavers in scoring twice, rebounding seven times, assists 10 times (with a career-high 11 dimes), steals six times and blocked shots four times.

EVERY SHOT IN THE BAG: Angus Brandt is seventh in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at 55 percent (104-of-189) and makes shots in a variety of ways, including right-handed and left-handed, inside and out. He has scored in double-figures in four consecutive games twice this season and is shooting a team-best 48 percent (24-of-50) from three-point land.

100+ SCORING GAMES: Oregon State has scored 100 or more points three times this season, matching a team record for 100-point games in a season that had previously been accomplished in 1978-79, 1979-80 and 1988-89.

90+ SCORING GAMES: Oregon State has scored 90 or more points in a school-record eight games this season (1979-80 and 1988-89 teams did it six times). The Beavers scored at least 90 points in four consecutive games for just the second time in school history to equal the 1980-81 team and scored 90 or more points in consecutive conference games (92 vs. California, 101 vs. Stanford) for the first time since 1978-79.

80+ SCORING GAMES: Oregon State has scored 80 or more points in 14 games this season, including streaks of four consecutive games on two occasions (OSU hadn't scored 80 or more points in four consecutive games since 1989-90). The Beavers scored 80+ points 10 times in Robinson's first three years and are now 20-4 under his watch when it happens, including an 11-3 record this season.

"FIRST TIME SINCE" AND "MOST SINCE" NOTES: Oregon State has several "first time since" and "most since" notes this season that are included in the above copy. Here are some others:

- Oregon State's 18-point win over Utah is its largest-margin of victory in a conference road game since the Beavers defeated Washington State by 20 (83-63) on Feb. 18, 1990.
- Oregon State defeated UCLA for the first time since 2005 to snap a 13-game losing streak to the Bruins and give Craig Robinson a win over every Pac-12 team.
- Oregon State has had six players reach double-figures in scoring twice this season (Dec. 18 vs. Portland State and Jan. 7 vs. Stanford). It's the first time since Jan. 25, 2003 (82-62 win over Washington) that six Oregon State players scored in double-figures in a game and the first time since 1991-92 when it happened twice in a season (112-87 win over Oral Roberts on Dec. 18, 1991 and 104-89 win over Sacramento State on Jan. 2, 1992).
- With Ahmad Starks (22), Angus Brandt (21) and Roberto Nelson (20) all scoring 20 points against Howard on Dec. 15, the Beavers had three players reach that mark for the first time since 2004.
- Oregon State had 27 assists on 40 made field goals in a 101-68 victory over Portland State on Dec. 18, the most since the team dished out 34 in a 116-78 win against UC San Diego on Nov. 25, 1997.
- In the Portland State game, Joe Burton (9) and Jared Cunningham (8) combined for 17 assists, the first time two Oregon State players had eight or more assists since March 2, 1991 when Charles McKinney (10) and Will Brantley (8) combined for 18 in a 91-69 win over Arizona State.
- Also in the Portland State game, the Beavers made a season-high 13 three-pointers, the most since it knocked down 14 against Howard on Dec. 20, 2008.
- Oregon State played its first quadruple-overtime in school history when it lost to Stanford, 103-101, on Jan. 7. The 204 combined points is the second-most in a game in Oregon State history. Loyola Marymount (117) and OSU (113) combined for 230 on Nov. 19, 1989.
- Oregon State set a single-game team record with 11 blocked shots against Stanford. The Beavers had 10 blocks in three previous games (vs. Texas-Pan American, 12/28/05; vs. Oregon, 1/30/99; vs. College of Notre Dame, 12/30/98).
- Oregon State lost back-to-back overtime games (Jan. 7 vs. Stanford, Jan. 12 at Arizona) for just the second time in school history and the first time since it fell to Washington State in OT on consecutive nights in 1938.

HEAD COACH CRAIG ROBINSON

Craig Robinson is in his fourth year at the helm of the Oregon State men's basketball team with a full roster of players he recruited and several marquee wins during his first three seasons as he continues to rebuild the Beavers historic program.

In his third season at Oregon State, Robinson led the Beavers to their first win over a Top 25 team (vs. No. 20 Washington) and first victory in the Pac-10 Tournament (vs. Stanford) since 2006. Oregon State also defeated Arizona to open conference play 2-0 for just the second time since 1992-93, its third consecutive win over a Wildcat team that eventually came within a basket from a trip to the Final Four.

Defensively, the Beavers used their 1-3-1, 2-3 and matchup zones, with some man-to-man mixed in, to be among the top teams in the nation in steals all season. Sophomore guard Jared Cunningham shattered Oregon State's sophomore steals record of 72 set by legendary Gary Payton in 1987-88 with 85 swipes. Cunningham was named to the All-Pac-10 Second Team and Pac-10 All-Defensive Team and also joined Payton as the only Oregon State players to make the Pac-10 All-Tournament Team.

Several freshmen had impact seasons, as Devon Collier broke the Beavers freshman single-season blocked shots record (23), Ahmad Starks made the third most three-pointers (42) by a freshman in school history and Roberto Nelson scored the most-ever points by a Beaver frosh (34) in a game.

For the third consecutive year under Robinson's watch, Oregon State players earned Pac-10 All-Academic honors as Angus Brandt and Rhys Murphy were both named to the First Team, to join Roeland Schaftenaar who was a two-time Pac-10 All-Academic recipient.

In his second year, Robinson guided Oregon State to a tie for fifth-place in the Pacific-10 Conference, the highest finish for the Beavers since 2004-05. The Beavers finished conference play with an 8-10 record, which tied for their most Pac-10 wins since 1992-93, and made a second consecutive postseason appearance in the College Basketball Invitational.

Robinson's second season also saw Oregon State capture a number of marquee wins, most notable of which were season sweeps of Arizona and Oregon. Oregon State's win at Arizona was its first there since 1983 and the win in Eugene was the first for the Beavers since 1993.

Seth Tarver was honored as the Pac-10 Defensive Player of the Year and Calvin Haynes was named to the All-Pac-10 Second Team after Robinson's second season.

In his first season at Oregon State, Robinson helped lead a remarkable turnaround that culminated in the Beavers capturing the College Basketball Invitational title with a best-of-three series win over UTEP. With the championship, the Beavers captured their first postseason men's basketball title in school history.

Oregon State finished the season with an 18-18 record and the plus-12 win total from the previous year ranked No. 3 in the country. The 18 wins were the most for Oregon State since 1989-90 and earned Robinson the District IX Coach of the Year by the United States Basketball Writers Association.

Along the way, Oregon State won seven Pac-10 games and swept the season series from California and Stanford, marking the first time since the 1989-90 season the Beavers have swept the two schools in the same year. The seven conference wins were the most for the program since 2004-05.

The fourth-year coach has also seen success on the recruiting trail as the Beavers have added numerous top-ranked recruits in his first three signing classes. The 2009-10 class signed by Robinson is one of the most decorated in program history and was ranked in the top 25 in the nation by several recruiting services.

Prior to joining Oregon State, Robinson spent two years as the head coach at Brown, leading a revival of the Bears program that he guided to a school-record 19 victories in his final season. In his second year at Brown, Robinson led the Bears to their fourth-ever postseason tournament. Robinson's team posted an 11-3 Ivy League mark, second best in school history, and good for second place in the conference. Robinson won more games (30) in his first two years than any other head coach in Brown basketball history.

Robinson made an immediate impact on the Brown basketball team in his first year at the program and was named Ivy League Men's Basketball Coach of the Year by BasketballU.com. He guided the Bears to an improved 11-18 mark and 6-8 in the Ivy League to finish fifth in the conference. The Bears had a stunning 51-41 victory over Providence College and limited the Friars to 14 second-half points and 18-percent shooting from the floor in the second half (4-of-22) and also held NCAA-bound Michigan State to 45 points, its lowest point total of the season.

Prior to Brown, Robinson worked at Northwestern, where he spent six seasons with the Wildcats under head coach Bill Carmody (former head coach at Princeton). Robinson's relationship with Carmody dates to the 1982-83 season when, as senior captain, he led Princeton to the second round of the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament, Carmody's first year as an assistant coach with the Tigers.

At Northwestern, Robinson developed and implemented his local, national and international recruiting technology. He was an integral part of Northwestern's dramatic turnaround, helping the Wildcats to the most wins in a four-year period in school history at the time with 57 victories from the 2001-2002 to the 2004-2005 seasons. Robinson also helped Northwestern finish ninth in the nation in scoring defense (58.8 points per game) in 2005-2006.

A 1983 graduate of Princeton with an AB (Arts of a Bachelor degree) in Sociology, Robinson is considered one of the top players in Ivy League history. He ranks fourth on Princeton's all-time scoring list with 1,441 points and led the Ivy League in field goal percentage in 1982 (.577) and 1983 (.642).

Robinson was also the league's first two-time honoree as Ivy League Player of the Year, sharing the honor in 1982 before winning it outright in 1983. He played under legendary Princeton coach Pete Carrill, leading the Tigers to two NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament appearances during his tenure (1981 and 1983). His 16 rebounds in a NCAA tournament win over Oklahoma State in 1983 ranks fifth in the Ivy League record book for NCAA games.

After graduating from Princeton with a degree in sociology, Robinson was drafted by the Philadelphia 76ers in the fourth round of the 1983 NBA draft. He played two seasons with the Manchester (England) Giants of the European Basketball League. He also served as the assistant to the general manager and public relations officer for Manchester.

Robinson began his coaching career as an assistant coach at the Illinois Institute of Technology from 1988-90. He was responsible for offense implementation, game strategy, recruiting and advance scouting. He was also the head coach at the University of Chicago High School in 1999-2000.

Robinson, who also has a MBA in Finance from the University of Chicago Graduate School of Business (1992), took a hiatus from coaching and went into private business in 1990. He was Vice President for Continental Bank from 1990-92, Vice President for Morgan Stanley Dean Witter from 1992-99 and then Managing Director for Loop Capital Markets before he made his move to Northwestern.

Robinson and his wife, Kelly, have two sons, Avery and Austin, and a daughter, Leslie.
