No. 13/13 COUGARS (25-7, 13-5 Pacific-10)

THIS WEEK: The Washington State Cougars, (No. 13 *Associated Press* /ESPN/USA Today) will face Oral Roberts in the first round of the 2007 NCAA Tournament in Sacramento, Calif., March 15...game time is 11:40 a.m. and will be aired on CBS...Cougars are the No. 3 seed in East Region.

ABOUT ORAL ROBERTS: The 14th-seeded Golden Eagles are 23-10 overall, and 12-2 in the Mid-Continent Conference...captured their second straight conference tournament title defeating Oakland, 71-67, March 6...senior Caleb Green leads the team in scoring (20.3 points per game) and rebounds (9.3 per game)...Green was named tournament MVP after putting up game-high 28 points in championship game...only game this season against a ranked opponent resulted in a 78-71 victory over No. 3 Kansas, Nov. 15...only team in the nation to lead its conference in scoring offense (72.3 points per game) and scoring defense (64.7 points per game).

TONY BENNETT ACCOLADES: Washington State Head Coach Tony Bennett has led the Cougars 25 wins this season, tied for second most in school history...named Pacific-10 Conference, United States Basketball Writers Association District 9, National Association of Basketball Coaches District 14, Collegeinsider.com Pacific-10 and *Basketball Times* national Coach of the Year.

MORE BENNETT: Tony Bennett is in his first season at the helm of the Cougar program...fourth year with WSU...assistant coach in 2003-04...associate head coach in 2004-05 and 2005-06...assistant coach at Wisconsin from 2000-03...became the first head coach at a current Pacific-10 institution to start 7-0 in his inaugural campaign at the school since Stanford's Robert W. Burnett was 9-0 in 1951-52...Bennett's accomplishment is tied for the third best start in a debut season at Pacific-10 school in the post-World War II era.

LOW AND WEAVER GARNER HONORS: Junior guards Derrick Low and Kyle Weaver were named All-Pacific-10 Conference and National Association of Basketball Coaches District 14 First Team...Low named first team for District 9 by the United States Basketball Writers Association...Weaver named MVP of the Pac-10 by Collegeinsider.com...first time since 1995-96 Washington State has placed a pair of student-athletes on the all-conference team.

BENNETT'S MID-CONTINENT LEGACY: Washington State Head Coach Tony Bennett's play at Wisconsin-Green Bay (1988-92) still resonates in the Mid-Continent Conference as he holds spots on numerous career record lists...Bennett, a two-time MCC Player of the Year (1991 and 1992), is the conference record holder and NCAA leader in career 3-point field goal percentage (49.7)...Mid-Continent career rankings include assists (second, 599), total points (fourth, 2,285), field goals (fifth, 792), and free throw percentage (fifth, 84.0)...also named Mid-Continent Newcomer of the Year in 1989.

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FROM THE DAIRY STATE TO THE BIG DANCE: For the second time in school history, Washington State opened its season in Wisconsin...both times, the Cougars earned a bid to the NCAA Tournament...in the 1982-83 season, WSU won its season opener 66-64 at Wisconsin...this season, the Cougars posted three wins (UAB, Wisconsin-Milwaukee and Radford) at the John Thompson Challenge in Milwaukee.

COUGARS EQUAL BEST PAC-10 FINISH: Washington State's 88-86 double overtime win over No. 23 USC last March 3 earned sole possession of second place in the final Pac-10 standings...first time WSU has finished in the upper division of the conference since a tie for fifth in 1994-95...equals best finish in Pac-10 history (1982-83).

WSU WINS PILING UP: The Cougars have won 25 games this season, tied for second most in school history...WSU posted 26 wins in 1940-41 (NCAA runner-up), and 25 in 1916-17 (national champions by the Helms Foundation of Los Angeles)...WSU's 13 Pac-10 wins are third in school history (14 in 1979-80 and 1982-83)...Cougars have won 14 more games than last season, second biggest improvement in school history (won eight in 1943-44 and 23 in 1944-45).

COUGARS IN THE POLLS: Washington State was 11th in the *Associated Press* poll last week and currently ranks 13th in the ESPN/USA *Today* poll...Cougars began receiving votes after upsetting then-No. 18 Gonzaga, 77-67 Dec. 5...earned first AP ranking (No. 22, Jan. 8) since Feb. 1983.

WSU IN NATIONAL RANKINGS: Thru games of March 8, the Cougars ranked nationally in fewest turnovers (third, 10.4 per game), scoring defense (14th, 58.8 points per game), win-loss percentage (tied-16th, 80.6), fewest personal fouls committed (21st, 15.9 per game), field goal percentage defense (30th, 40.3), scoring margin (44th, +7.9 points per game) and blocked shots (45th, 4.6 per game)...Kyle Weaver ranked 31st in steals per game (2.2).

COUGARS IN PAC-10 RANKINGS: Washington State leads the Pacific-10 in scoring defense (59.1 points per game), turnover margin (plus 3.56 per game), and assist to turnover ratio (1.35)...rank second in field goal percentage defense (40.5) and blocked shots (4.47)...third in 3-point field goal percentage defense (33.0), scoring margin (plus 7.4 points per game) and 3-point field goal percentage (37.2).

GET THAT SHOT OUT OF HERE: In 2005-06, Washington State tied a school record with 130 blocks shots...eclipsed the mark this season and currently has 143 (4.47 per game) through 32 outings...set a single-game school record with 12 blocks in the 58-45 win over then-No. 25 Stanford, Feb. 8...Ivory Clark leads the Cougars with 46 blocks.

DEFENDING THE PERIMETER: Washington State has blocked 20 shots opponents have taken beyond the arc this season...Kyle Weaver leads the team with 14 followed by Ivory Clark with five and Taylor Rochestie with one.

GOOD DEFENSE: This season, Washington State has held 12 opponents, including the last nine, without a field goal for a span of at least five minutes during a game.

COUGARS KNOCK OFF NATION'S ELITE: Washington State has posted wins over No. 18 Gonzaga (Dec. 5), No. 7 Arizona (Jan. 6), No. 20 Arizona (Feb. 1), No. 25 Stanford (Feb. 8) and No. 23 USC, March 3...equals most ranked opponents defeated in one season (1994-95)...first time in school history Cougars have defeated at least two ranked opponents in consecutive seasons...last season, WSU defeated No. 10 Washington in Seattle and a Huskies' squad ranked 16th-nationally in Pullman.

SEASON SWEEPS COMPLETED: Washington State swept home-and-home series with six Pacific-10 Conference opponents this season, most in school history...recorded its first season sweep of the Arizona schools in Cougar history after wins at then-No. 20 Arizona (72-66, Feb. 1) and Arizona State (48-47, Feb. 3)...also the first road sweep of the desert schools since 1981-82...Washington State knocked off Arizona State 75-55, Jan. 4 in Pullman...followed up that performance with a 77-73 overtime victory over then-No. 7 Arizona to snap a 20-game home losing streak to the Wildcats...completed its second straight home-and-home sweep of Washington with a 65-61 victory in Seattle, Feb. 14...also defeated the Huskies 75-47, Jan. 20 at home...first back-to-back home-and-home sweeps of Washington since 1967-68 and 1968-69 seasons...WSU lost twice to Oregon and UCLA and once to Stanford this season.

REWRITING HISTORY: The Cougars 28-point margin of victory (75-47) over the Huskies, Jan. 20, marked the largest win over the Huskies in the team's 261 meetings...largest victory over a Pac-10 team since a 101-64 win against Oregon State in Pullman, Feb. 17, 1994.

COUGARS REPRESENTATION: The WSU men's basketball team currently holds the most diverse roster in the Pacific-10 with seven states, the District of Columbia, and three foreign countries represented...leads the conference with 11 different representations...Pacific-10 conference is the most internationally diverse conference in NCAA Division I...has a total of 24 student-athletes represented by 16 different countries.

NCAA CONNECTIONS: Several coaching staff members of teams in the 2007 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship field of 65 have ties to Washington State University.

WEAVER MAKES HISTORY: Junior guard Kyle Weaver is the first player in Pac-10 history to register 300 points (341), 125 rebounds (166), 125 assists (141), 50 steals (65), and 35 blocks (39) in the same season...first player in WSU history to have 140 assists and 140 rebounds in the same season.

COUGARS AGAINST NCAA TEAMS: Washington State has faced six teams in the 2007 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship...Cougars posted a 6-6 record...all-time, WSU has played 35 schools in this year's field of 65.

COUGARS BRING IN CROWDS: Washington State drew 104,525 fans to Friel Court this season (7,466 average)...highest average attendance since 1995-96 (8,107)...only other season WSU drew over 100,000 total was 1979-80 (110,206)...Cougars sold out games against Gonzaga (Dec. 5), Washington (Jan. 20), UCLA (March 1) and USC (March 3)...in addition, 11,092 were in attendance to see the 77-74 overtime loss to then-No.7 Oregon, Jan. 27...first time in school history, WSU has played at home five times in front of crowds of 10,000 or more...Cougars' 75-47 victory over the Huskies, Jan. 20, was witnessed by the largest crowd (11,618) at Friel Court since 12,422 were on hand to see the Cougars defeat No. 6 UCLA, March 7, 1983.
