WASHINGTON STATE (10-9, 3-7 Pac-10)

COUGARS HOST LOS ANGELES SCHOOLS: The Washington State men's basketball team will look to grab another win against a ranked opponent when it hosts No. 13 (AP)/No. 12 (ESPN/USA Today) UCLA, Thursday, Feb. 9, at 5:30 p.m., and USC, Saturday, Feb. 11, at 3 p.m....both games will be televised by FOX Sports Net.

THE HEAD COACHES: Dick Bennett is 35-41 at Washington State and in his third season on the Palouse...owns a 489-298 career record (.621) in 27 collegiate seasons...guided Wisconsin to 2000 Final Four...Ben Howland is 48-32 and in his third season at UCLA...overall record is 216-131 in 12 seasons...Tim Floyd is 15-7 in his first season at USC...overall record is 258-137 in 13 seasons...Bennett is 1-4 against Howland and 1-5 vs. UCLA (1-4 as WSU head coach)...Bennett is 4-1 vs. USC and is 0-1 against Floyd.

ABOUT UCLA: The Bruins lead the Pacific-10 Conference with a 9-2 conference mark...UCLA is 19-4 overall...Bruins need one win for their first 20-win season since 2001-02...UCLA is second to Washington State in scoring defense among Pac-10 schools at 60.7 points per game...Bruins are tops in the conference in field goal percentage at 47.9...Jordan Farmar leads the Pac-10 in assists per game (5.76), is fourth in assist/turnover ratio (1.55), 10th in steals (1.24 per game), and 12th in scoring (13.6 points per game)...Arron Afflalo is fifth in scoring (17.4 points per game), 3-point field goals made (2.22 per game) and free throw percentage (81.8) and 17th in rebounding (4.7 per game).

SERIES WITH THE BRUINS: UCLA leads 88-13...Bruins hold a 39-11 advantage on the road, including 37-11 in Pullman...Bruins have won last 12 on the road against the Cougars, including 11 straight at Friel Court (1995-96 game was played at Spokane Arena)...Washington State is 3-60 all-time against a ranked UCLA team...Bruins won first meeting 63-61 in Los Angeles, Jan. 12.

ABOUT USC: The Trojans are 15-7 overall, 6-5 in the Pacific-10...USC leads the Pac-10 in 3-pointers made per game at 6.41...Gabe Pruitt leads the conference in 3-pointers made with 2.68 per game, is second in steals (2.27 per game), fifth in minutes played (34.14 per game) and seventh in scoring (17.0 points per game) and free throw percentage (80.0)...Nick Young is sixth in scoring (17.1 points per game), eighth in field goal percentage (49.5), and ninth in rebounding (6.3 per game) and minutes played (33.32 per game)...Abdoulaye N'diaye is second in blocked shots (1.59 per game) and tied for 19th in rebounding (4.6 per game).

SERIES WITH THE TROJANS: Southern Cal leads all-time series 63-36...Washington State holds a 24-22 advantage at home, including 23-21 in Pullman...Cougars have won last two at home (Spokane in 2004 and Pullman in 2005)...the team winning the season's first meeting has swept the home-and-home each of the last six seasons...USC won the first meeting this season, 71-66 Jan. 14 in the final games between the two schools at The Los Angeles Memorial Sports Arena.

THIS DATE IN COUGAR HISTORY (Feb. 9): WSU opened with an 18-4 run on its way to an 84-64 victory over visiting USC, Feb. 9, 1995...win extended Cougars' win streak at Friel Court to 13 games...all five Cougar starters scored in the opening run...the Trojans trailed by double figures the final 14 minutes of the game...Donminic Ellison handed out 13 assists and added four steals...WSU converted 21 of 29 shots (72.4 percent) in the second half.

THIS DATE IN COUGAR HISTORY (Feb. 11): Marv Harshman's Cougars held Stanford to shoot just 35.6 percent from the floor, to beat the Cardinal 82-58, Feb. 11, 1967...WSU shot 54.2 percent shooting from the field, and out-rebounded the Cardinal 54-41...Ted Wierman led the Cougars tallying 20 points...Jim McKean added 15 points and 17 rebounds for the Cougars.

COUGARS WIN FIGHTS WITH DAWGS: Washington State swept Washington in the season's home-and-home series for the first time since 1994...Cougars defeated the 10th-ranked Huskies 78-71 in Seattle, Jan. 4...victory broke a 34-game losing streak overall to top 10 teams and snapped an 11-game skid at Washington...first road win in school history against a top 10 opponent...sophomore Josh Akognon set a career-high with 27 points, shooting 6-for-10 beyond the arc...guard Kyle Weaver was 8-for-10 from the field, scored a career-high 19 points, and added six assists...Cougars held the Huskies to 40.2 percent shooting from the floor...five players tallied double-figure scoring in WSU's 77-64 win over No. 16 Washington in Pullman, Feb. 4...largest margin of victory over a top-25 team since an 84-71 win over No. 15 Arizona State in Pullman, March 4, 1995.
