Sponsored by Boeing, the Apple Cup trophy is presented annually by the governor of the state of Washington to the winner of the match-up between Washington State University and the University of Washington.

Though the 2009 meeting between the Cougars and Huskies will mark the 102nd game played between the two teams, the Apple Cup has only been a staple of the series for the past 40-plus years.

With the state of Washington being famously known for its apples, the Cougars and Huskies began playing for the Apple Cup trophy in 1962. Since the institution of the Apple Cup, WSU trails in the series 15-32, but has won four of the last five meetings, including a 16-13 double-overtime victory last season in Pullman, the 101st game played between the Cougars and Huskies. UW leads the all-time series 64-31-6.

From 1934-61 the winner of the cross-state rivalry was awarded the Governor's Trophy. WSU claimed the Governor's Trophy eight times during that span, with the Huskies winning 16 games and the schools ending in a tie on three occasions.

The first meeting between WSU and UW was played in 1900, with the schools playing to a 5-5 tie in Seattle. Since that time the Apple Cup has determined the Pacific-10 Conference Champion and a trip to the Rose Bowl on a number of occasions, making the rivalry game one of the fiercest in college football.
