## Where Are They Now?



**Jenni Ruff**

1993-96, set WSU single season records in 1996 for scoring (685 points), free throws made (203), and scoring average (23.6 ppg). She finished ninth nationally in scoring for the season. She played for the Long Beach StingRays and San Jose Lasers of the American Basketball League.

**Yvonne Kunze**

1995-98, ranks in top 10 on Washington State's career list in field goal percentage, scoring and rebounds. Played professionally in Germany and was a member of the German national team.



**Heather Norman**

1989-92, holds the record for the most three-pointers made in a career at WSU with 133. She is currently the senior woman administrator at Gonzaga University.



**Susie Jarosch**

1991, 93-95, has played on Danish and Swedish professional teams. Founded High Five Agency, which specializes in representing professional women's basketball players.



**Kelli Kronberger**

1993-96, led her team in three-point field goal percentage. She hit seven in a game twice in one season. She is now head basketball coach at Northwest Nazarene University.



**Doreen Evans**

1995-98, Team captain for two years. Earned team's Strength and Conditioning, Defensive Player and Most Inspirational award after her senior season. Has worked at the Pac-10 and Western Athletic Conference.



**Emma Joneby**

Currently playing professionally in Sweden for Club 08 Stockholm. In her senior year, tallied five double-doubles, which was fourth in the Pac-10. Recorded 13 double-digit scoring games in her career. A 3-time All-Pac-10 Academic honoree.



**Amy Saneholtz**

1994-97, holds single game rebounding record with 22 and is the 13th all-time leading scorer. She currently coaches at Montana State.



**Camille Thompson**

1991-94, ranks in top ten on Cougars' career list in field goal percentage, scoring, rebounds and free throws. Former member of Canadian national team.

**Jade Hyett**

1996-97, has played in the Australian professional league. She was the first player in history to lead the Pac-10 in assists (7.6 per game) and steals (4.6) in the same season.

**Dawn Allinger**

1988-91, three-time conference all-academic selection. Selected to WSU's All-Decade Team. Participated in the 1996 Olympics as a member of the team handball team. Served as team handball analyst for NBC Sports at the 2004 Olympics.
