COMING UP NEXT: Washington State (5-23 overall; 1-17 Pac-10) takes to the court in the first round of the 2007 State Farm Pac-10 Women's Basketball Tournament...the Cougars take on the UCLA Bruins (13-17 overall; 7-11 Pac-10) Friday, Mar. 2 at 6:00 p.m....all Pac-10 Tournament games will be held at the HP Pavilion Center in San Jose, Calif...the winner of Friday's WSU-UCLA game will advance to play No. 2 seed Arizona State at 1:15 p.m. Saturday, Mar. 3.

COUGAR RECAP - OREGON STATE 65, WSU 61: Kate Benz picked up her second double-double of the season with 12 points and 14 rebounds while Amanda DuRocher recorded a career-high 24 points on 6-of-12 shooting from three-point range...WSU dominated much of the first half, using a 20-2 run to take a 12-point lead into halftime...the Cougars led by as many as 17 points before Oregon State pulled to within seven after two successful Casey Nash free throws...OSU regained the lead, which they had not done since 12:43 in the first half, with a 15-3 run late in the second half...the Beavers hit 7-of-8 shots from the free throw line in the closing minutes of play to seal the victory...as a team, WSU shot a season-high 47 percent from the three point line and outrebounded the Beavers 44-27.

A LOOK AT THE BRUINS: UCLA finished the regular season with a seventh place conference finish and a Pac-10 record of 7-11...the Bruins are led by Noelle Quinn who is averaging 17.0 ppg and 6.9 rpg to lead the team in both categories...Quinn is fifth in the conference in points and tenth in rebounds...Lindsey Pluimer is contributing 15.6 ppg and scored 15 against Stanford and 18 against California...as a team, the Bruins rank second in the conference in three-point percentage, shooting 35 percent from beyond the arc, and second in rebounds with 40.5 rpg...UCLA is looking to snap a five-game losing streak...the Bruins, however, defeated Stanford 85-76 in overtime to clinch the 2006 Pac-10 Tournament title and earn the conference's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

THE UCLA-WSU SERIES: The Bruins are 2-0 against the Cougars in 2007 but have won both games by a combined six points only...UCLA defeated WSU 74-71 Dec. 29 in Pullman, then came back from a 12-point deficit to edge the Cougars by three in Los Angeles, 73-70 Jan. 28...the Bruins have now won the last 13 straight games with WSU's last win coming Jan. 6, 2001 in Pullman.

BENZ GRABS WSU's ALL-TIME CAREER REBOUND

TITLE: Kate Benz picked up 11 rebounds Thursday, Feb. 22 against Oregon to claim WSU's all-time career rebound title...the 6-foot-2 forward cleared Cassandra Overby's career total of 875 to claim the top spot...with 14 rebounds against Oregon State Feb. 24, Benz's career number now stands at 896...Benz also needs just six more points to become the 11th women's basketball player in WSU history to reach 1,000 career points...if Benz picks up just six more points and four more rebounds, she would become the first person in WSU women's basketball history to reach 1,000 career points and 900 career rebounds.

A LOOK AT ARIZONA STATE: The winner of Friday's WSU-UCLA game will advance to play No. 2 seed Arizona State Saturday, Mar. 3 at 1:15 p.m....the Sun Devils are ranked ninth nationally in the Associated Press poll while the USA Today/ESPN/WBCA poll has ASU ranked eighth in the country...the team finished 16-2 in conference play to place second in the Pac-10... the Sun Devils hold the top-rated offense in the conference, posting 75.2 ppg...the team is also first in the Pac-10 in free throw percentage (73 percent), field goal percentage (48 percent), assists (18.86 apg), and steals (10.17 spg)...Emily Westerberg leads the Sun Devils with 13.8 ppg...she is 11th in the conference in scoring.

FIRST HALF HIGH: WSU scored 39 points in the first half against Oregon State Saturday...39 points was a season high for points scored in the first half for the Cougars...the most points scored in any half this season was 47 in the second half against Sacramento State Nov. 17.

JUST ONE MORE GAME: Senior forward Kate Benz has played in 112 games during her four year career...that number ties her for second on WSU's all-time career games played list...Dawn Allinger (1988-91) and Heather Norman (1989-92) share the second spot with Benz.

A FRESH START: The 2006-07 season featured five true freshmen: guard Colleen Betteridge, guard Nakejia Kelly, guard Alexa Price, guard Jamie Roupp, and forward Marisa Stotler...this season marked the most since the 1997-98 season when six true freshman appeared on the WSU roster...the Cougars have been receiving big numbers from Stotler who is averaging 10.3 ppg...Stotler, a native of Chandler, Ariz., has posted three double-doubles and 13 double-digit scoring games this season...she is also leading the team in steals with 50...Seattle, Wash., native Betteridge is averaging 2.5 assists per game and has appeared in every game this season...Roupp has provided a spark off the bench for the Cougars, appearing in every game since Feb. 3 against Arizona State...she has recorded nine assists, seven rebounds and three steals in eight games...Alexa Price is averaging 4.3 minutes per game in fourteen games...Nakejia Kelly was averaging 7.6 ppg but was declared academically ineligible and was unable to complete the season.

LINE CHANGE: Washington State head coach Sherri Murrell used her tenth different starting lineup of the season Saturday against Oregon State...the latest combination included freshman forward Marisa Stotler, senior forward Kate Benz, sophomore guard Katie Appleton, sophomore guard Amanda DuRocher and junior guard Dani Montgomery...Katie Appleton is a mainstay in the Cougar lineup and has started 26 games for WSU...Kate Benz, Colleen Betteridge, Marisa Stotler and Ebonee Coates are the only four Cougars to have appeared in all 28 games this season.

WSU IN THE PAC-10: As a team, WSU is seventh in three-point field goal percentage, shooting 29 percent from beyond the arc...the Cougars are sixth in the Pac-10 with 37.7 rebounds per game...the team also ranks eighth in blocks with 2.32 blocks per game and eighth in steals with 7.04...WSU is also fourth in offensive rebounds (14.71 orpg) and seventh in defensive rebounds (22.96 drpg)...the Cougars are sinking 4.15 three-point shots per game, sixth in the conference...individually, Marisa Stotler's 10.3 ppg are 17th in the conference while Kate Benz is eighth in the Pac-10 in rebounding (7.1 rpg)...Ebonee Coates ranks eighth in blocks...Stotler is eighth in the steals category with 1.79 steals per game...Amanda DuRocher is seventh in three-point field goals made with 1.30 per game.

COUGAR INJURY REPORT: Senior Adriane Ferguson is suffering from a stress fracture in her right foot...she appeared in both games over the weekend but has not practiced regularly with the team since Feb. 12...senior Kate Benz continues to be hampered by chronic back pain and spasms.

COUGAR CLOSE CALLS: Despite the Cougars' 5-23 overall record, WSU has taken their opponents to the brink on several occasions...six games this season have been decided by five points or less while 12 matches have been decided by less than ten points...WSU lost by a combined 15 points against No. 22 California and No. 10 Stanford Jan. 11 and 13...most recently, WSU fell 66-61 to the Oregon State Beavers in Pullman Feb. 22.

WELCOME BACK: WSU women's basketball assistant coach Lisa Fisher returned to her coaching duties Friday, Feb. 16...Fisher has been on leave for the majority of the season after giving birth to twin girls Nov. 24, 2006.

COUGAR HOLD 'EM: WSU held Oregon to 19 points in the first half, the second lowest first half total by any Cougar opponent this season...so far, WSU has limited its opponents to 25 points or less in the first half seven times this season...the Cougars held the California Golden Bears to a 17-point first half performance Jan. 11.

YOU'RE INVITED TO A BLOCK PARTY: Sophomore Ebonee Coates is WSU's leader in blocks with 31 and is eighth in the Pac-10...Coates had four blocks against the Arizona Wildcats Feb. 1...she had a career-high six blocks against Northwestern State Dec. 17 and tied a WSU single game record...she has posted at least one block in 17 games this season and is three blocks shy of cracking the top-ten list for single season blocks.

STEALING THE SHOW: WSU is averaging 7.04 steals per game...Marisa Stotler owns a team-leading 50 steals (1.79 per game) while Ebonee Coates has contributed 29 steals this season...Coates posted a season and career-high six steals against No. 12 Arizona State Feb. 3...six steals places her 11th all-time for single-game steals...Amanda DuRocher recorded a career-high three steals Feb. 1 against Arizona, then repeated the performance with three steals at Stanford Feb. 8...Stotler posted three steals against Oregon Feb. 22.

A FULL SLATE: The 2006-07 season marks the longest in program history...the Cougars will play 30 games this year, including the first round of the Pac-10 Conference Tournament...the team played 29 games in a season in 1982, 1991, 1996 and 2002.

NON-CONFERENCE ROUND UP: The Cougars finished their non-conference schedule with a 5-6 record...WSU faced one nationally-ranked opponent Kentucky (No. 15/16) and fell to the Wildcats, 80-51...staged the 11th biggest comeback in WSU women's basketball history, Dec. 2 against Eastern Washington as WSU was down by as many as 11 points in the second half before capturing a 76-70 victory.

KELLY DECLARED ACADEMICALLY INELIGIBLE: Freshman guard Nakejia Kelly has rendered herself academically ineligible for competition during the spring semester, per NCAA regulations, it was announced January 11..."Our goal is to help Nakejia academically so she will be eligible next year," said Head Coach Sherri Murrell...Kelly will forego practicing with the team in an effort to concentrate on her academics...Kelly averaged 7.6 points in 16 games and dished out 24 assists...her scoring and assist totals both ranked third among the 13 Cougar players who have seen action this season.
