HENAHAN 100 FLY ALL-AMERICAN

Senior Lindsay Henahan opened day two of the NCAA Swim Championships with a 16th place finish in the 100 butterfly in a time of 54.02, becoming WSU's first All-American since Erin Eldridge in 1999.

The co-captain from Rochester, N.Y., had to overcome a flight delay in Denver due to a snowstorm. The delay, which began after boarding her 11:45 a.m. MST flight on Tuesday, March 18, kept Henahan from arriving at the championships in Auburn until 12:30 a.m.CST Friday. Her best event, the 100 butterfly began at 11 a.m. Friday. Henahan was supposed to race in the 50 freestyle Thursday, but missed the event.

Henahan had to train for her event at a Holiday Inn in Denver about 17 miles from the airport. Due to the fact that the stranded passengers did not have access to their luggage, Henahan had to purchase a swimsuit and goggles from the hotel gift shop. After arriving in Auburn, Henahan received her luggage and was able to race in her racing suit.

Henahan ended her swimming career at Washington State University with a 68th place finish in the 100 freestyle at the event.

COPLAND MAKES WAVES AT U.S. NATIONALS

Freshman Jane Copland finished 21st in the finals of the 200m breaststroke at the 2003 U.S. National Championships. Copland, a native of Wellington, New Zealand, posted a time of 2:36.95 in the preliminaries 200 breaststroke.

Copland earned an automatic qualification for the event with a seventh place finish of 2:15.71 (SC) at the Pacific-10 Championships (March 1). The qualifying standard for the U.S. Nationals is 2:18.29 (SC).

At the meet, Copland also swam a preliminary time of 1:14.78 in the 100m breaststroke. She went on to improve her mark by time trialing in 1:14.60. Her personal best in the event is 1:14.50.

Prior to the Cougar swimming season, Copland made an impact at the Pan Pacific Swimming Championships as she competed against world-class swimmers from several different countries.

The highlight of the Pan Pac's for Copland was her performance in the 200m breaststroke. Copland finished 15th in the event with a time of 2:36.40.

WSU SWIMMING NO. 2 ACADEMICALLY

The Washington State University women's swim team ranked second in the nation academically for the fall 2002 term by the College Swim Coaches Association of America.

The Cougars continued in their tradition of academic prowess with a team semester grade-point average of 3.533, placing them No. 1 in the Pac-10 Conference for the sixth consecutive year. The team's national ranking of second also makes Washington State one of only two Pac-10 teams ranked in the top-50 nationally. California is the only other Pac-10 school ranked in the top-50 nationally at 46 (3.097).

WSU COACH ERICA QUAM

Quam comes to the Palouse from Southern Methodist University, where she served as assistant coach for five years. During her first year as head coach at WSU, Quam accumulated a dual meet record of 4-5.Quam graduated from Indiana University in 1997. For the Hoosiers, Quam swam the breast and IM events. She also was team co-captain her junior and senior years. Quam also served as a student assistant coach during the 1996-97 season.

Andria Giovanni (Free, Bremerton), Laurie Gregg (Free/Back/IM, Los Altos, Calif.), and Katie Van Horne (Free, Healdsburg, Calif.), have signed National Letters of Intent to swim at WSU beginning this fall.

Giovanni swims at Central Kitsap High School. Her junior season, as an individual she placed sixth in the 100 free and seventh in the 50 free, both at the State level. She received All-America consideration for her performance in the 400 free relay. This past season, Giovanni helped to lead Central Kitsap to a fourth place finish at state. Giovanni finished fifth in the 50 free, sixth in the 100 free and was a member of the second place 400 free relay.

Gregg swims for Mountain View High School and with the Stanford Covington Racing Aquatics. During her first three years with Mountain View, Gregg was named all-league twice and earned All-American honors as a member of the 200 and 400 free relay teams Last season, Gregg's first place finish in the 100 free and 200 free helped to lead the Spartans to the league championship. With her club team, Gregg was selected to the Western Zone All-Star Team in 2002.
