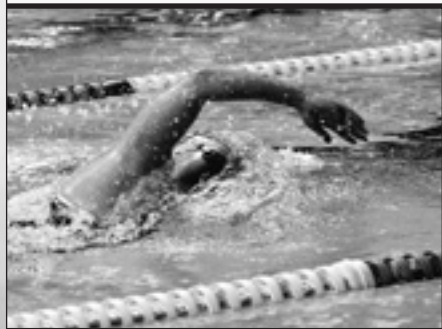

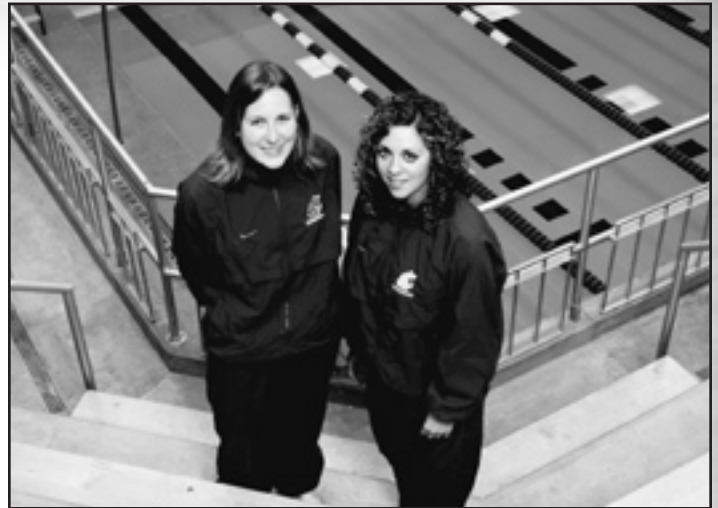
HIGH SCHOOL/ CLUB CAREER

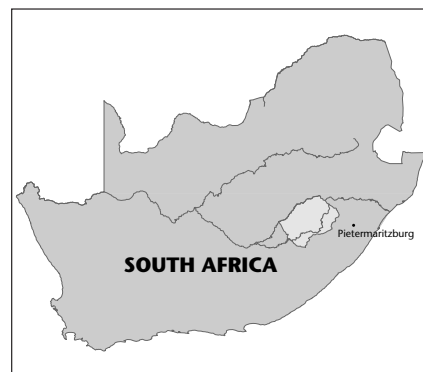
