Transportation on Official Visits – On-Campus

An institution transporting a prospective student-athlete around campus during the official visit must use institutional vehicles normally used to transport prospective students while visiting the campus. In addition, coaching staff members or student hosts may use personal vehicles to transport a prospective student-athlete around campus during an official visit.

Official Visit Information – Entertainment 13.6.7

- WSU may provide entertainment within 30-mile radius off campus.
- WSU may provide a maximum of 3 complimentary admission tickets.
- A WSU Student Host can have up to \$40 to use with the recruit for entertainment and meals.
- A WSU staff member may provide a lunch, dinner, or brunch to prospects on an official visit as long as the cost does not exceed normal cost of student life.

NCAA News:

Over the course of the week Sports Illustrated released a yearlong investigation into the Oklahoma State football program. SI reported that Oklahoma State players accepted various payments from coaches and boosters. Additionally, players were not attending class and were having course work completed for them. The article also chronicles a widespread abuse of the drug policy and instances where hostesses in the Orange Pride program were providing sex to recruits.

As a result OSU president Burns Hargis issued the following statement regarding the allegations;

“Oklahoma State University is deeply troubled by these claims. We will investigate the accuracy of the allegations and take all appropriate action. We do not condone or tolerate improper conduct in our athletic programs. OSU requires everyone affiliated with the university to follow the rules and adhere to the highest ethical standards.”

OSU athletic director Mike Holder also issued a statement addressing the allegations;

“We are shocked by the allegations raised about our football program. We take the



allegations seriously. Whether they have merit or not, we don't know. But we will find out.

Our athletic department understands the high expectations OSU president Burns Hargis and the OSU board of regents have set for us. Our coaches and staff understand we will not tolerate any violations that compromise our pursuit of excellence, the highest of ethical standards and full compliance with NCAA rules and regulations.

We are committed to playing by the rules on and off the field. We strive to be a source of pride for our fans, our university and the Big 12 Conference."

OSU has notified the NCAA and the Big 12 Conference about the article being released by SI. The school is bringing in an outside investigator to ensure the current program is NCAA compliant.
