Requirements for Official Visits

A high school or preparatory school prospective student-athlete must present the institution with a score from a PSAT, SAT, PLAN, or ACT taken on a national testing date under national testing conditions, except that a state-administered ACT may be used to meet the requirements.

A prospective student-athlete must present WSU with a high school (or college) academic transcript.

A high school or preparatory school prospective student athlete must register with the NCAA Eligibility Center.

A high school or preparatory school prospective student-athlete must be placed on the institution's institutional request list (IRL) with the NCAA Eligibility Center.

NCAA News: Iowa State commits recruiting violations

As a result of self-discovered and self-report of recruiting violations in all Iowa State University sports, the Division I Committee on Infractions concluded that the university failed to monitor its athletics program. Over a three-year period, athletics department staff members placed more than 1,400 impermissible recruiting calls to nearly 400 prospects. Additionally, a former student men's basketball coach sent 160 impermissible text messages to prospects and also placed impermissible recruiting telephone calls.

Penalties in this case, the majority of which were self-imposed by the university, include a two-year probation period, a reduction in official paid visits and restrictions on recruiting-related telephone calls.
