Tip of the Week

Student-Athletes Engaged in Athletically Related Activity During a Required Day Off (I)

NCAA Division I institutions should not that all countable athletically related activities are prohibited during one calendar day per week during the academic year. A student athlete may engage in voluntary athletically related activity during the student-athlete's required day off, provided the activity was initiated and requested solely by the student-athlete; however related activity becomes countable if:

- A) The student-athlete is required to report back any information about the activity to a coach or other athletics department staff member, or any athletics department staff member who observes the activity reports back any information about the activity to a coach;
- B) The student-athlete is required to participate in the activity
- C) The student-athlete's attendance and participation in the activity (or lack thereof) is recorded for the purposes of reporting such information to coaching staff members or other student-athletes; or
- D) The student-athlete is subject to penalty for failing to participate in the activity, or receives recognition or incentive (e.g., awards) based on his or her attendance or performance in the activity.

National Letter of Intent --- 5 Rules to Remember



1. Parent or guardian must sign NLI if PSA is under 21.
2. PSA may not sign NLI before 7am on the initial signing date.
3. The NLI is valid for 7 days from the issuance date. WSU has 14 days to file signed NLI with the Pac-12 office.
4. It is permissible for media, parent, relatives, friends, and high school administrators to be present at signing. It is **NOT** permissible for athletics representatives of WSU to be present during NLI signing.
5. You may **NOT** hand deliver NLI off-campus. However, you may provide NLI/athletic aid agreements on an official/unofficial visit.

Please Remind PSA...

- Cannot sign NLI before 7am local time on the initial signing day
- Be sure to complete the “date” & “time” portion of the NLI

Souvenirs on Official Visits



On an official visits a maximum of \$40 is provided for each day of the visit to cover all actual costs of entertaining the student host(s) and the prospective student-athlete, as well as the prospective student-athlete's parents, legal guardians or spouse. The entertainment allowance may **NOT** be used for the purchase of souvenirs, such as T-shirts or other institutional mementos.

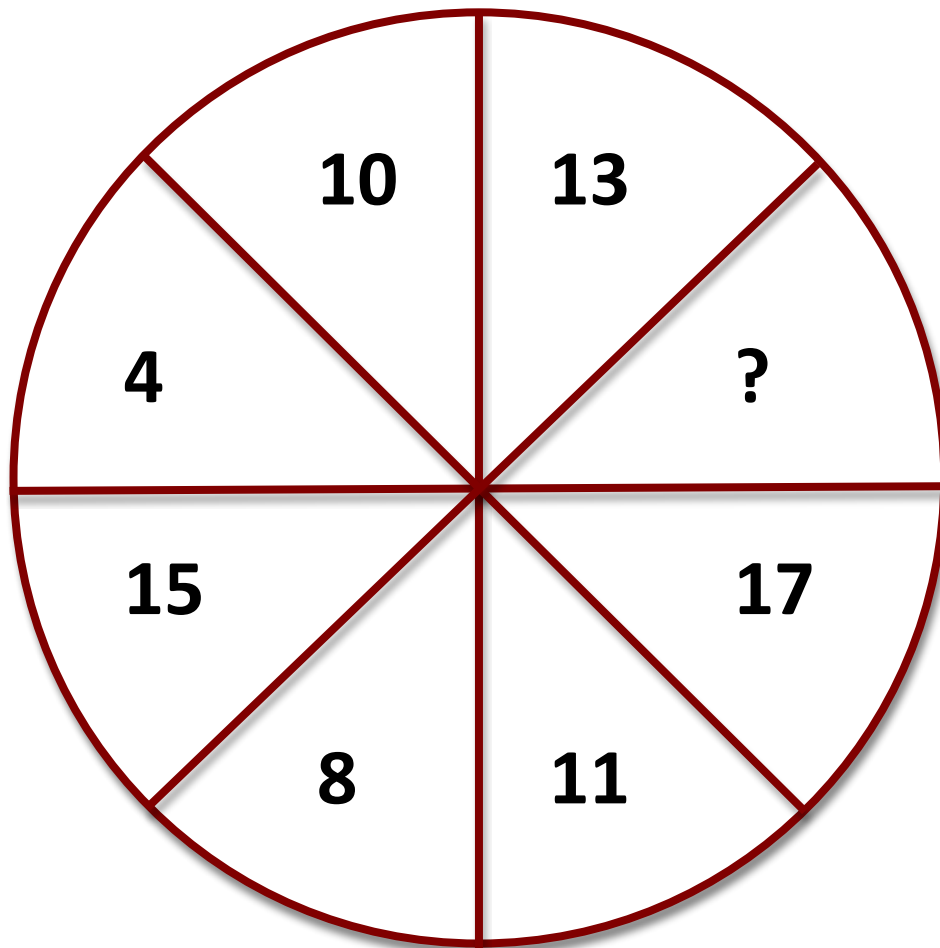
