# **Tip of the Week**

# **Expenses from an Outside Sponsor**

An individual who participates in a sport as a member of a team may receive actual and necessary expenses for competition and practice held in preparation for such competition (directly related to the competition and conducted during a continuous time period preceding the competition) from an outside sponsor (e.g., team, neighbor, business) other than an agent or a representative of an institution's athletics interest (and, after initial full-time collegiate enrolment, other than a professional sports organization). An individual who participates in a sport as an individual (not a member of a team) may receive actual and necessary expenses associated with an athletics event and practice immediately preceding the event, from an outside sponsor (e.g., neighbor, business) other than an agent or a representative of an institution's athletics interest (and, after initial full-time collegiate enrollment, other than a professional sports organization).

Reference Bylaw 12.1.2.1.4.3

- 1. On Thursday night an institution's couch picks up a prospective student-athlete from the nearest major airport on arrival for an official visit. The coach drives the prospective student-athlete directly to an off-campus hotel and instructs the prospective student-athlete to have dinner on his or her own at some point during the evening. The next morning, the coach transports the prospective student-athlete from the hotel to campus. When does the 48-hour period begin for this prospective student-athlete?
  - a. Once the coach begins to transport the prospective student-athlete from the nearest airport.
  - b. Once the prospective student-athlete arrives on campus on Friday morning.
  - c. Once the prospective student-athlete arrives at the hotel Thursday night.
  - d. Once the prospective student-athlete has dinner on his or her own.
