# Electronic Correspondence During Official Visit in Cross Country/Track & Field, Football and Swimming and Diving

The committee determined that, in cross country/track and field, football and swimming and diving, any form of electronic correspondence (e.g., text messages) may be sent to a prospective student-athlete or those individuals accompanying the prospective student-athlete during the prospective student-athlete's official visit transportation and during his or her official visit, provided the correspondence is sent directly to the prospective student-athlete (or those accompanying the prospective student-athlete) and is private between only the sender and recipient.

# **COMPLIANCE QUIZ**

# **Expenses to Attend an Institution Camp or Clinic that Conducts Organized Competition**

The Legislative Council determined that an individual may receive actual and necessary expenses to attend an institutional camp or clinic from an outside sponsor (e.g., team, neighbor, business) other than an agent or a representative of an institution's athletics interests (and, after initial full-time collegiate enrollment, other than a professional sports organization), provided the camp or clinic conducts organized competition in the sport for its participants.
