# **Tip of the Week**

## **Transfer Requirements – General Principle**

A student who transfers (see Bylaw 14.5.2) to a member institution from any collegiate institution is required to complete one full academic year of residence (see Bylaw 14.02.11) at the certifying institution before being eligible to compete for or to receive travel expenses from the member institution (see Bylaw 16.8.1), unless the student satisfies the applicable transfer requirements or qualifies for an exception as set forth in this bylaw.

# College Coach Observing Enrolled Student, Student-Athletes and Prospective Student-Athletes Athletes Athletically Related Activities Outside the Playing Season

The academic and membership affairs staff confirmed that an institution's coaching staff member may not observe enrolled students or student-athletes in nonorganized athletically related activities (e.g., "pick-up" basketball games) outside the institution's declared playing season. A coaching staff member may observe enrolled students or student-athletes in organized athletically related activities (e.g., demonstration at a coaches' association convention, summer basketball league, intramurals), provided the coach does not direct or supervise the organized activity. If prospective student-athletes are also participating in the organized athletically related activities, the institution's coaching staff member may observe such athletically related activities only if it occurs during a permissible contact or evaluation period, or in men's basketball, a recruiting period. The staff noted that, in individual sports, a coach may participate in individual-workout sessions with student-athletes from the coach's team during the summer, provided the request for such assistance is initiated by the student-athlete.
