**Institutional Promotion of Noninstitutional Camps and Clinics (I)**

A member of the institution's coaching staff who is employed at a noninstitutional camp or clinic may only promote or endorse such a camp or clinic by permitting the camp or clinic to use his or her quotations and/or pictures in its promotional materials (e.g., camp brochure, website, social media). It is not otherwise permissible for an institution or an institution's coaching staff member to produce and/or post noninstitutional camp or clinic promotional material (e.g., camp brochure, website, social media). In addition, it is not permissible for the institution or the institution's coaching staff member to include information regarding a noninstitutional camp or clinic, in which the coach is employed, in general or electronic correspondence.
